

OCUDU Releases

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Releases

OCUDU is an open-source initiative awarded initial funding by the National Spectrum Consortium (NSC) under a three-year programme running through October 2028. See the [NSC announcement](#) for details.

The first public release, v26.04, shipped in April 2026. The project follows a predictable bi-annual release cycle: new versions ship every April and October to ensure steady feature development, community feedback integration, and long-term sustainability.

Current Features

Radio & Physical Layer

- FDD/TDD, all FR1 and FR2 bands
- All bandwidths up to 100 MHz (FR1) and 400 MHz (FR2)
- 15, 30, and 120 kHz subcarrier spacing
- All physical channels
- QAM-256, 4x4 MIMO DL and UL
- Optimised LDPC/Polar codecs for ARM Neon and x86 AVX2/AVX512
- SSB-based and CSI-RS-based radio link monitoring
- NTN GEO support

Protocol Stack

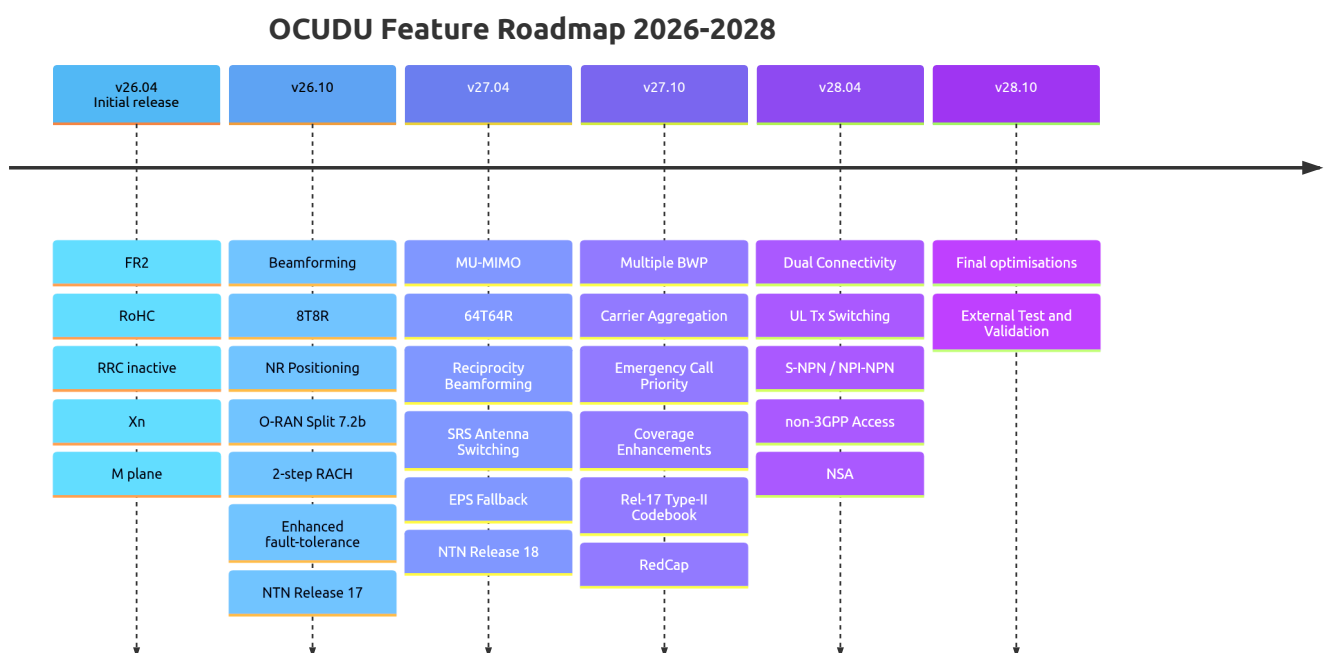
- All RRC and MAC procedures
- All handover and mobility types over NG and Xn (including Conditional HO)
- Robust Header Compression (RoHC)
- RRC_INACTIVE support
- NRPPa using RSRP and SRS
- RAN slicing

Architecture & Deployment

- CU/DU and CU-CP/CU-UP separation
- Split 7.2a via in-house Open Fronthaul library
- M-plane support via OCUDU helper components
- Hardware accelerator support via DPDK BBDEV
